The Colorado Reined Cowhorse Association hosted their March Madness show on March 6-7 at the Douglas County fairgrounds in Castle Rock, Colo.

Darren Miller, Watkins, Colo., won and tied himself for third and fourth place paychecks in the 8 entry open derby class. He rode Todd Thieszen's buckskin gelding Shiner Bock Nic, 5, to mark the high scores in the herd and cow work divisions to earn the championship and \$1,066 in all. He is sired by Night Time Shiner out of Diggers Diamond Nic.

"I want to credit my good helpers, Brianna Targis and Sonja Hennerickson, for getting all the horses ready for me," said Miller. "It takes especially good teamwork to show a lot of horses at a smaller show like this."

The show attracted 72 entries and paid out \$6481 in the NRCHA approved division. The jackpot division hosted 53 entries and paid out \$1325 in all.

Jim Cook, Erie, Colo., was reserve champion riding Pam Bailey's mare Misters Miss Remedy to earn \$689 for his efforts. Miller's third and fourth place entries were Rhoda Rein's Lil Cooter Lena and Shiners Diggen It, co-owned by Miller and Tom Monckton.

Ty Rohrbaugh won the limited open derby riding Chris Kelly's horse I CD Prize. EJ Laubscher was reserve champion riding Haidas San Sonita for owners Jane & Theron Johnson of Colby, Kans.
